All Ages Hammered for Habitat

Friends of Paterson Habitat for Humanity from across North Jersey were invited to The Paterson Museum on Saturday, November 5, 2016 for a morning of fun, wall building and fund raising to support Paterson Habitat's mission of helping families build strength, stability and self-reliance through shelter.

Teams of volunteers (faith organizations, schools and businesses) sponsored boards for a Habitat house with a \$250 donation. Family teams also participated by sponsoring boards at a \$100 donation rate. The highlight of the morning for the 215 participants was hammering their boards into wall modules that will become part of a Habitat house in Paterson.

In a special Hammering 4 Habitat tradition, teams inscribed their boards with personal messages to future homeowner families. Everyone was welcome to stop by and see the great work Paterson Habitat supporters were doing for the city of Paterson.

The morning also included family fun activities sponsored by Home Depot of Paterson and Indian Hills High School Interact Club of Wyckoff. Food and refreshments were sponsored by Shoprite of Passaic. A new addition to our activities this year included two tours of the Great Falls National Park and Paterson's historic area led by "MeetPaterson".
